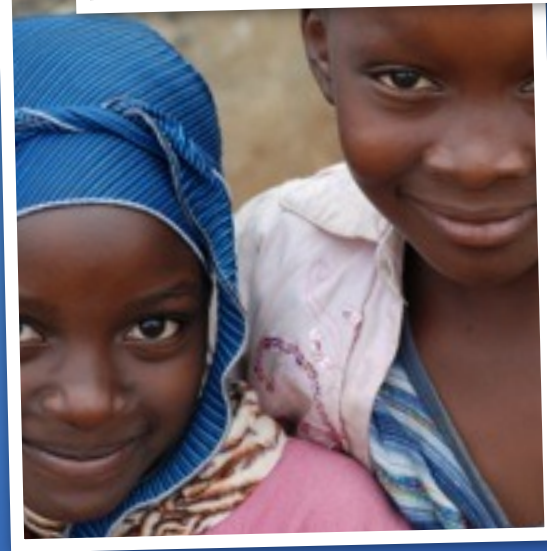

ABOVE: A typical classroom in Nigeria. No power, no books. Students copy information from the blackboard into their composition books for memorization. 95% of Nigeria's classrooms have no textbooks.

Give the gift of education by providing resources. An eGranary has 15 million documents of educational material. Hooked up to used laptops and a power source this gives students a digital library to explore without need for power, internet or books.

For each computer lab in a school serving 500 students

WE NEED:

-20 working used laptops with their power cords

-funds for the generator & power regulator \$ 1000

-funds for one eGranary digital library \$1500

-scholarships \$150/year

that averages \$5/per student for a world of opportunity, inquiry and learning

2010 Nigeria Project Goals met

eGranary and computer lab installations

What a joy to be a part of community that is dedicated to and working for a better future!

Working with government officials a public school site was chosen for a new pilot program. Students, faculty and administrators all celebrated in the triumph of the completed computer lab installation in the Gov't Science School Kuru networked with a digital library (with 15 million educational documents) providing access to resources for 1000 students.

Creative Minds International Academy (our 2007 pilot in a private school) received a new updated eGranary with an additional 10 laptops for their computer lab as well as new ethernet switch and voltage stabilizer. The lab has been functioning for 3 years, changing the lives of faculty and hundreds of students.

Other Networking

Besides the computer lab installations and peace conference, we made prison and youth home visits and met with youth groups in the area also interested in learning how to promote peace in their community.

There is tremendous opportunity to further support and empower local youth interested in steering the course of their nations future.
